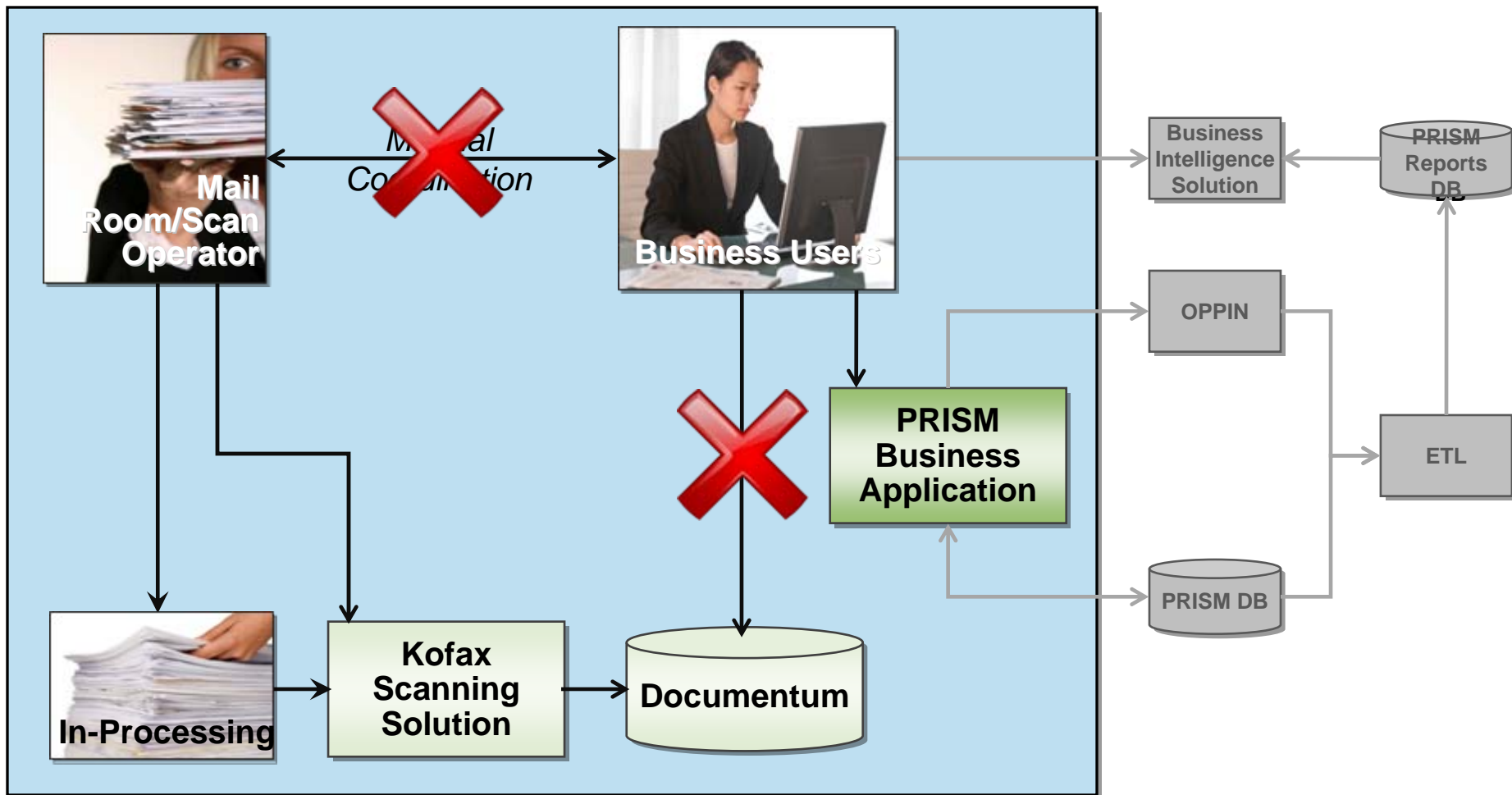

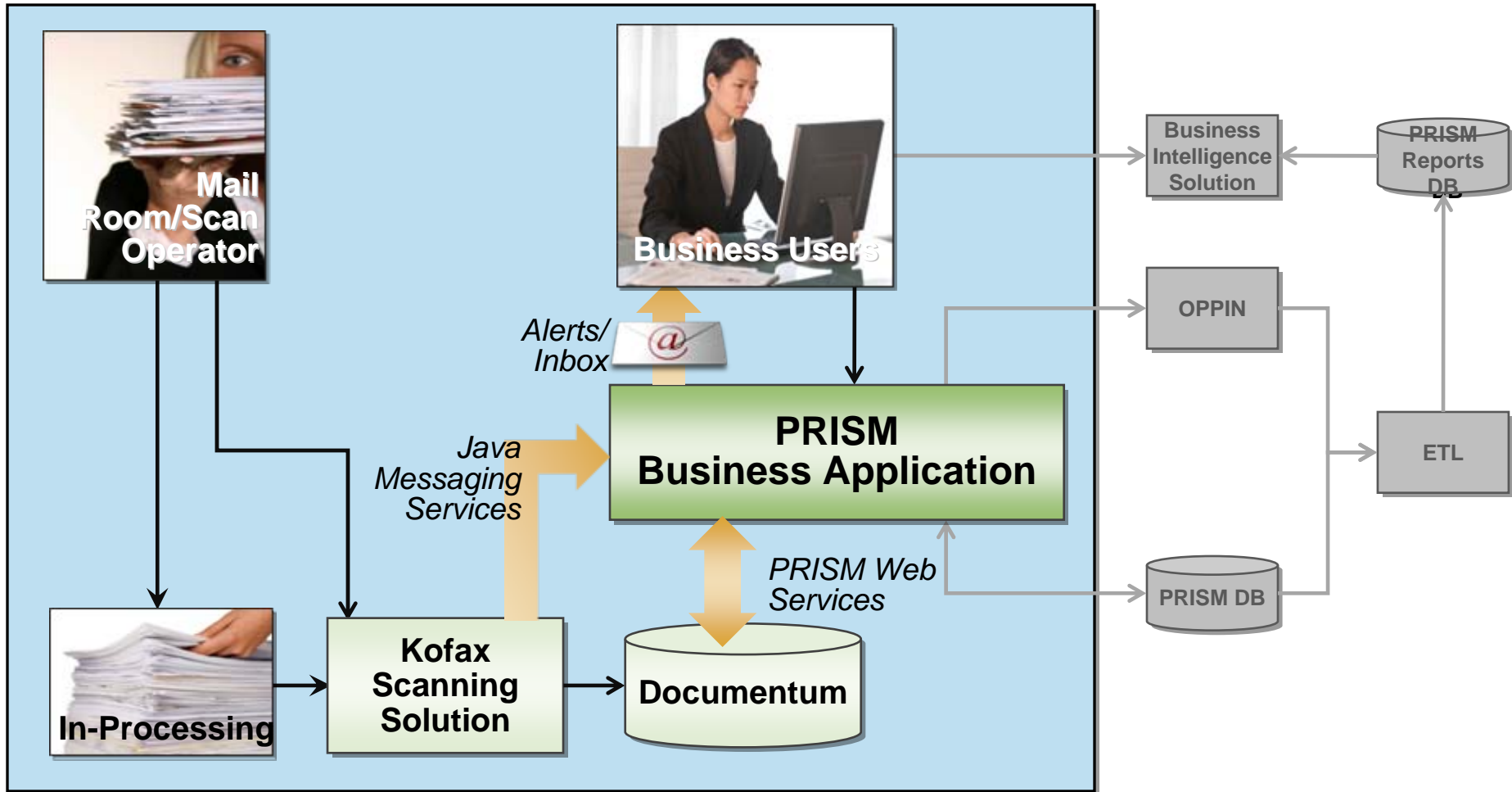

What is PRISM?



- A *flexible and powerful web-based case management framework* that seamlessly integrates Documentum and other systems into a single business application
- *Case Managers are in complete control* of the tasks, actions and team members that are needed to complete the project, while the system tracks all documentation and ensures easy record retrieval
- *The system makes it easy to track workload* by placing all tasks in a centralized inbox

PRISM Benefits



- Centralized Inbox and Notifications
 - Promotes timely completion of tasks by providing users with an “Inbox”, which displays the user’s tasks and notifications, along with the associated due dates, instructions and general assignment information
- Easy to use Wizards
 - Provides the ability to create Data Call-Ins (DCIs) for the Endocrine Disruptor Screening Program (EDSP) via a user-friendly wizard, which simplifies an otherwise cumbersome and time-consuming process
- Integrated Status Dashboards
 - Presents all relevant information grouped by an intuitive tabbed interface along with an integrated high-level management project status dashboard which tracks overall completion rates for milestones and tasks

Additional PRISM Benefits



- Enables users to strategically manage resource allocation and task deadlines
- Tight integration with Documentum allows users to submit, upload, check-in/check-out and track deliverable documents, associate reference documents to tasks, and view document metadata
- Interfaces directly with Kofax in order to route incoming documents directly to the appropriate user, streamlining OPP's workflow process
- Supports management oversight and tracking initiatives through the generation of enterprise level reports

Additional PRISM Benefits (cont)



- Flexible framework that allows for the dynamic creation of tasks throughout the project lifecycle
- Provides centralized, role-based management of all active and completed projects and tasks to enable efficient retrieval and record keeping across the enterprise
- Allows users to search a staff member directory to establish a list of team members to work on their projects
- Supports the auto-generation and population of commonly used EPA forms, which significantly reduces manual effort
