The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 6 have determined that the former Naval Weapons Industrial Reserve Plant in McGregor, Texas (the "Property") is Ready for Reuse.

As documented in the Ready for Reuse Determination Letter of October 30, 2006, the Ready for Reuse Determination is an acknowledgment that environmental conditions on the Property are protective of human health and the environment, based on its current and anticipated future use for commercial, industrial and agricultural purposes.
