

# SmartWay Transport Partnership

SmartWay upgrade kit demo projects call for projects RFP - Border area is eligible - [RFP guidelines](#).



The SmartWay<sup>SM</sup> Transport Partnership (SmartWay), established by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in 2004, is a voluntary, public-private partnership with the ground freight industry. Truck and rail freight is integral to the nation's economy; however, heavy-duty diesel vehicles are major consumers of fossil fuels and major contributors to air pollution. The SmartWay Transport Partnership promotes a variety of strategies designed to reduce energy consumption and vehicle emissions that also

lead to a reduction in costs for truck and rail freight operators.

The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) is partnering with EPA to support the SmartWay initiative in the Dallas-Fort Worth area. The NCTCOG is currently seeking applications from companies with Class 8 heavy-duty diesel vehicles who are interested in outfitting their trucks with SmartWay Transport Partnership Upgrade Kits. Applications must be received between January 15 and February 23, 2007.

## *"Get Cash the SmartWay, We Can Help"*

Grants are available for trucking companies trying to save money and help the environment. The North Central Texas Council of Governments and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency are testing a program aimed at reducing emissions and improving fuel efficiency.

Companies with Class 8 heavy-duty vehicles are interested in the SmartWay Transport Partnership upgrade kits **must apply between January 15 and February 23, 2007**. Single-wide tires, auxiliary power units, trailer aerodynamics, and diesel oxidation catalysts are among the products covered. NCTCOG will pay for 100 percent of emissions-control technology and 50 percent of other strategies.
