The Toxics Release Inventory Made Easy (*TRI-ME*) software is a tool to help facilities in determining and completing their Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) section 313 obligations. With *TRI-ME* Reporting Year (RY) 2005, you can fill out, certify, and submit your TRI forms through the Internet via EPA's Central Data Exchange (CDX), EPA's portal for online reporting.

TRI-ME RY 2005 has integrated the TRI Forms Modification Rule changes. The rule eliminates some redundant or seldom used data elements and modifies other reporting requirements on the TRI Reporting Forms. *TRI-ME* will assist you with any changes.

How will using *TRI-ME* and submitting via CDX help me?

- It will save you time and money!
- Using *TRI-ME* will significantly decrease your chance of making mistakes!
- EPA provides instant confirmation of your submission to keep for your records!
- Electronic Signature allows for quick, paperless submissions!
