difficulties. Rather she is distressed, uncomfortable, upset, and unhappy by the pain and other potential limitations and difficulties that this produces for her and in her relationship with her husband when she is feeling poorly. This does not appear in any way to be an abnormal psychological reaction, but a very normal one to a set of conditions which are reportedly uncomfortable, painful, distressing, somewhat limiting, despite the fact that she is able to carry out a substantial number of important and useful activities and gain considerable pleasure from her marriage, her work, and her pursuits such as her new home. It probably would be appropriate for Mrs. Booty to obtain some help with regard to additional efforts at pain management although very possibly her difficulties with pain are sufficiently specifically related to her medical condition that little may be offered in that regard and I would defer opinions on that to her other doctors in conjunction with pain experts. In any case, I see no evidence for neurological disorder, decline, disability or dysfunction, and nothing about her psychological condition rises to the level of an emotional disturbance or disability or requires a psychological diagnosis.

Thank you very much for the opportunity to see this woman. Please let me know if I can provide additional information or be of any further help.
