

Continuing Integration of P2 into Compliance Efforts through Multiple Projects, Diverse Resources and Organizations

Description

This session will provide examples of how compliance assistance and pollution prevention can be successfully integrated into businesses through multiple approaches such as industry specific assistance programs, through compliance inspections, permit writing, etc. This session highlights the cooperation between programs and agencies that has resulted in improved compliance, minimization of waste and improved relationships between the regulatory agencies and the regulated entities (businesses).

Compliance Assistance Centers, Interagency Regulatory Integration of Pollution Prevention Programs and Pollution Prevention Supplemental Environmental Projects (P2 SEPs) case studies are tied together here to demonstrate the successes and inter-connections.
