Environmental dredging is expected to begin in mid-May and continue through late fall of 2009 in the Kinnickinnic River between Becher Street and Kinnickinnic Avenue. The dredging will remove approximately 170,000 cubic yards of contaminated sediment. The dredged sediment will be barged to the Milwaukee Confined Disposal Facility on Jones Island. During the dredging, boat traffic will be restricted through this area and street closures (Kinnickinnic Avenue and 1st Street) will occur. This project is the result of a partnership and strong cooperation between the U.S. EPA, WDNR, City of Milwaukee, Port of Milwaukee, Army Corps of Engineers and the local Business Improvement District #35.
