Attn: Chemical Right-to-Know Program – Re-designation of two HPV chemicals

Dear Administrator Whitman,

The DuPont Company requests the re-designation of two chemicals sponsored by DuPont as “No longer HPV”. The chemicals are Cyclohexane, oxidized, non-volatile residue, CAS# 68411-76-7 and Nickel, bis[(cyano-C)triphenylborato(1-)-N]bis(hexanedinitrile-N,N’)-, CAS# 83864-02-2. DuPont no longer manufactures either of these two chemicals and we do not import any quantities of the two chemicals. It is our understanding that no other company manufactures either of the two chemicals.

For the reasons listed above, DuPont requests that these two chemicals be assigned an indicator “5” (No longer HPV), on the EPA HPV list, that DuPont’s name be removed as sponsor, and that the chemicals be removed from consideration for any HPV-related test rules.
