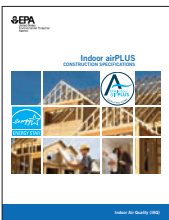


Indoor airPLUS Better Environments Inside and Out

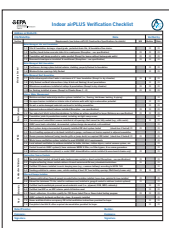


Indoor airPLUS Construction Specifications
