April 1 – June 30, 2007**

BEP met with local air, pre-treatment, and hazardous waste inspectors on May 3 to initiate development of the multi-media inspection form and protocol of the drycleaner ERP project.

Information on dry cleaning establishments using perchloroethylene in Washoe County was provided by the Washoe District Health Department Air Quality Management Division and organized in spreadsheet fashion. The Clark County Department of Air Quality and Environmental Management was contacted to obtain information on dry cleaners in Clark County.

Inspection forms were provided by the Reno and Sparks pretreatment programs, the Washoe District Health Department Air Quality and Environmental Services Divisions and by the NDEP Bureau of Waste Management. BEP also obtained and reviewed the inspection forms and questions utilized by the MA Dry Cleaning ERP. BEP has compiled the inspection form questions into a multi-media format and is working on refining the questions for objective clarity and completeness.

In July we will be meeting and going over the questions to finalize the wordage and format of the forms.

A group of Washoe County Dry Cleaners were contacted to invite their participation in a Focus Group for the project.

BEP participated on a web conference demonstration of the ERP automation database developed by Massachusetts and Tetra-Tech.

BEP has requested a copy of the database from Massachusetts for use in the project.
