Worked on various projects ranging from sewer and water lines to heavy dirt moving in PA. Main focus was dirt and highway construction. Started as an equipment operator and worked into field foreman.

Worked for HRI, Inc. in the same industry, along the way we becoming involved in landfill construction and ultimately spent about 5 years at the Wayne Twp. Landfill building new fields, gas collection systems and capping old closed parts of the landfill. Worked on a new field construction project at Lycoming County Landfill for 1 year. Started as an equipment operator and worked into general superintendent.

Hired on at CCSWA in 1996 as the field foreman, overseeing field operations.

Hired on at CCSWA in 1997 as general manager overseeing day to day operation and reporting back to 9 Board of Directors. Transformed a municipal waste landfill getting 95% of income from MSW only to a diversified facility with multiple sources of income including; MSW, residual waste, C&D waste, **methane gas sales**, wood recycling, mulch sales, trucking of waste and recycling income at the county level to include curbside collection and maintaining 25 drop-off centers around the county.
