TESTER (D-MT) introduced **S.608** to amend the **Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008** to exclude secondary sales, repair services, and certain vehicles from the ban on lead in children's products. (S3163)

DURBIN (D-IL) introduced **S.624** for himself and others to provide 100,000 people with first-time access to **safe drinking water** and sanitation on a sustainable basis by 2015 by improving the capacity of the United States Government to fully implement the Senator Paul Simon Water for the Poor Act of 2005.
