DEFENDANT: Longley Jones Management Corporation
N.D. New York DNYN506CR000190-001

FACTS: Longley Jones manages commercial and residential real estate, including numerous apartment buildings throughout central and upstate New York. The investigators found that employees of Longley Jones illegally removed and disposed of regulated amounts of friable asbestos in 98 buildings owned, managed or otherwise controlled by Longley Jones over the past 20 years.

DATE: 06/13/2006 Longley was charged with eight counts; one count of conspiracy, a violation of 18 U.S.C. 371; and seven counts of violating the CAA {42 U.S.C. 7413(c)(1)}.

STATUTE: 18 U.S.C. 371, 42 U.S.C. 7413(c)(1)

DATE: 06/13/2006 Longley pled guilty to all counts charged in the Information.

DATE: 07/10/2006 Longley was sentenced to pay a \$3,200 special assessment and a \$4 million fine, \$3 million of which will be suspended if it is used for asbestos clean up at various Longley Jones facilities that the company has already initiated.
