Also, measures (988 and 992) are not calculated from a representative sample of the regulated entity universe. The percentages are based, in part, on the number of regulated entities that answered affirmatively to these questions on voluntary surveys. The percentages do not account for the number of respondents who chose either not to answer these questions or the survey.</p>
<b>Note 2</b>	<p>For measure 179 (% of concluded enforcement cases requiring that pollutants be reduced, treated, or eliminated and protection of populations or ecosystems), only actions with direct environmental benefits/response/corrective action are counted. A detailed definition of these types of actions can be found in note 2 of the meta-data for NETs chart C-2.</p>
<b>Note 3</b>	<p>For measure 180 (% of concluded enforcement cases requiring implementation of improved environmental management practices), 1) preventative actions to reduce the likelihood of future releases and 2) facility/site management and information practices (FMIP) actions are counted.
