

SUBJECT: Availability of FY 2010 DWSRF Funds

Final enacted FY 2010 DWSRF funding is now available. This memorandum provides final state allotments based on the national appropriation of \$1,387,000,000. Attached are the State allotments (attachment A), the allotment of territory funds (attachment B) and the Regional Tribal Allocation (attachment C). This is the first year that the results of the 2007 Drinking Water Infrastructure Needs Survey and Assessment were used to determine the allotments.

As you know, DWSRF regulations state that "all payments to a State will be made by the earlier of 8 quarters after the capitalization grant is awarded or 12 quarters after funds are allotted to a State" (40 CFR 35 § 3560(b), "Timing of Payments"). This means that payments from the FY 2010 allotment must be made no later than the earlier of 8 quarters after a capitalization grant is awarded or the second quarter of FY 2013.
