


Verify Registration Process

In order to access Verify in order to submit compliance data, all companies must first complete two steps:

1. Request a Manufacturer Code for your company from Verify. EPA assigns a Manufacturer Code to each company that intends to sell vehicles or engines in the United States. The Manufacturer Code is a 3-character alphanumeric code (e.g. "EPA"). Instructions for requesting a Manufacturer Code can be found at: <http://www.epa.gov/otaq/verify/mfr-code.htm>.
2. Register all users that will be submitting compliance data to Verify on behalf of that Manufacturer Code. All users that will be submitting information to Verify must receive a Verify/CDX user account that is affiliated with only one EPA Manufacturer Code. This is for information security purposes. After completing the user registration process, each user will have a Verify/CDX User ID and password. The Verify password must be changed every 90 days. Request a Manufacturer Code

This web page provides information for vehicle or engine manufacturers seeking to obtain an EPA manufacturer code and have their company registered with EPA. See the [basic information](#) page and the [questions and answers](#) page for more information on Verify and CDX.

All companies that plan to certify vehicles or engines with EPA must first obtain a three-character EPA manufacturer code. This code will be used in each certified engine family name and provides a direct link to the certifying company. The processes are described in further detail below.

Manufacturers New to EPA Who Do Not Have a Manufacturer Code

If you are a new manufacturer who has not obtained a three-character manufacturer code from EPA, please follow the steps in the [manufacturer code request instructions \(PDF\)](#) (EPA420-B-08-008, 15 pp, 794K, April 2008). Obtaining a manufacturing code is done via the Agency's Central Data Exchange (CDX). (CDX is the single point of entry for electronic environmental information submissions to the Agency.) Once you complete this process, the manufacturer code for your company will be sent to your business e-mail address.

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Manufacturers Who Already Have a Manufacturer Code, But Are New to the Verify Information System

If you are a manufacturer who obtained a manufacturer code prior to October of 2006, and now need to submit information to the Verify information system for the first time, you will need to have your manufacturer code re-issued electronically. Establishing Individual User Accounts

Once your company has obtained a manufacturer code electronically through the above procedures and is ready to submit compliance information to EPA through the Verify information system, the next step will be to register individual users as submitters to the Verify information system. The procedures on this page assume that a manufacturer has an EPA manufacturer code **and** that the code has been entered in the Verify information system. If you have not completed both of these steps please see the [manufacturer code](#) information to complete that process before engaging in any of the procedures below.

EPA must collect the information described here to ensure compliance with the Cross-Media Electronic Reporting Rule (CROMERR). This rule, finalized in October 2005, establishes provisions, procedures, and standards for electronically reporting various types of information to EPA. Required Documents

EPA's Compliance and Innovative Strategies Division (CISD) must hold hard copy (wet ink signed) forms of the following documents before a manufacturer's Verify accounts can be created or activated.

1. Electronic Signature Agreement from Company Approving Official

The Electronic Signature Agreement (ESA) from the Company Approving Official (CAO) identifies the company officer responsible for designating individuals with authority to represent the company and conduct company transactions through the Verify information system. This ESA must be signed by the CAO as well as the CAO's immediate supervisor or an official witness (such as a vice president or Director of Human Resources). The original completed document ("wet ink signed") must be sent to CISD's Verify team by the US Postal Service or a package delivery service. Electronic files and telephone facsimiles will not be accepted. The document should be sent to the [address](#) below.

- Download, complete, print, and mail this [blank CAO ESA \(Word\)](#) (2 pp, 35K, April 2008).

2. User Authorization Letter and User Information

The CAO's ESA identifies and records the company official who is responsible for information submission to CISD. However, a company's CAO may wish to designate other users to carry out day-to-day interactions with the Verify information system: submitting files, requesting certificates of conformity, sending documents, etc. The CAO may designate others to perform these tasks by submitting a user authorization letter and user identification information. This letter must be sent to CISD by the US Postal Service or a package delivery service. Electronic files and telephone facsimiles will not be accepted. The letter should be sent to the [address](#) below.

- [blank user information form \(XLS\)](#) (1 pp, 19K, February 2008)

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3. Submitter Electronic Signature Agreement

The last required form is the submitter electronic signature agreement. With this form each user agrees to abide by the rules of the Verify information system. CISD must receive a signed ESA for each user must before their account can be activated. Users must send their ESAs to CISD by the US Postal Service or a package delivery service. Electronic files and telephone facsimiles will not be accepted. This submitter ESA should be sent to the [address](#) below. Note that CAO's who also intend to become Verify information system users must also submit a separate submitter ESA.

- Download, complete, print, and mail this [blank submitter ESA \(Word\)](#) (2 pp, 36K, November 2007).

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User CDX Account Setup

After CISD receives, evaluates, and approves the documents listed above, CISD will forward the approved submitter contact information to the CDX Help Desk where the user account information will be created. After entry, the Help Desk will then send each approved individual user a confirmation e-mail message, which will include a URL for registration completion and instructions telling the user to call the CDX Help Desk to complete the registration process.

Once the user calls the Help Desk, the Help Desk will call the user back at the phone number specified in the user information spreadsheet to authenticate the caller's legitimacy. At that time, the Help Desk will provide each user with a unique customer retrieval key (CRK), which is needed to complete the last step of the registration process.

In the final steps each user will go to the CDX web site located at the URL provided in the confirmation e-mail and enter the CRK in addition to other account information. Once the user registration process is complete, users will be logged in and may then immediately begin using the Verify information system.

Once a user has established a Verify/CDX user account, they must log in to Verify at <https://cdx.epa.gov/>. They will be prompted to enter their Verify/CDX User ID and password. After successful login, they will then be directed to their Verify home page which is referred to as "MyCDX" (see next section: MyCDX- Verify's Home Page).



Verify/CDX Inbox

Each Verify user will have their own Verify/CDX inbox and will receive messages from either the CDX Administrator or Verify Administrator. Users will receive the following types of messages in their inbox:

- Submission processing reports (from Verify Administrator)
- Submission status notifications (from either CDX or Verify Administrator)
- Database reports requested by the user (from Verify Administrator).

If a message has not been opened yet, it will have an envelope graphic () to the left of the sender of the message. Messages can be downloaded, printed or deleted.



Verify Submission XML File

The copy of the Submission XML file that is included in the inbox message from the Verify Administrator includes all of the information for the dataset that was submitted to Verify. This XML file can be saved to the user's workstation so that it can be viewed or used for a subsequent dataset submission.

Verify Submission Processing Reports

A Submission Processing Report will be sent to the user's CDX Inbox for each dataset transaction that is submitted to Verify by that user. After clicking on the link to the Submission Processing Report XML file, a formatted copy of the report should automatically open using an XSL style sheet that is embedded inside the XML file.

The Submission Processing Report XML file can also be saved to the user's workstation and either viewed or used later for another submission. This is especially useful for the Vehicle Information and Test Information dataset where one of the key identifiers of the dataset (primary keys) that will be needed for subsequent corrections to the dataset is assigned by Verify. For the Vehicle Information dataset, the "Configuration Number" is assigned by Verify and for the Test Information dataset, the "Verify Test Number" is assigned by Verify. If the original Submission XML file is reloaded for the purposes of submitting a correction, these EPA-generated fields will not be included automatically and if left blank, the submission will be rejected.

The Submission Processing Report specifies whether the submitted dataset was "Accepted" or "Rejected" by Verify. If the dataset was accepted by Verify, it will include all of the data submitted by the user as well as a section called "EPA Generated ... Details" where any EPA-generated fields for the dataset are displayed.



Transaction Message Text : VI-BR22 - If Transmission Type (VI-36) is equal to 'M' (Manual), then Transmission Lockup (VI-38) must be equal to 'N' (No).
Transaction Message Text : VI-BR17 - If Air Aspiration Device Configuration (VI-26) is equal to 'N' (Single), then Number of Air Aspiration Devices (VI-25) must be 1.
Transaction Message Text : VI-BR16 - If Air Aspiration Method (VI-23) is equal to 'TC' (Turbocharged), 'SC' (Supercharged), 'TS' (Turbocharged and Supercharged) or 'OT' (Other), then Air Aspiration Device Configuration (VI-26) is required, otherwise it is not allowed.

Verify's Light-Duty Home Page

After clicking on “VERIFY: Light-Duty”, the light-duty Release 4b home page will be displayed. Since Vehicle and Test Information supports several of the light-duty modules, it is listed as a separate link at the top of the list of light-duty modules. The “Upload Compliance Documents” link that is included on the light-duty home page will take users to the same screen as the link that is included on the Verify Home Page.

Aftermarket alternative fuel converters do not need to submit any of the Fuel Economy or In-Use Verification Program (IUV) datasets at this time.
