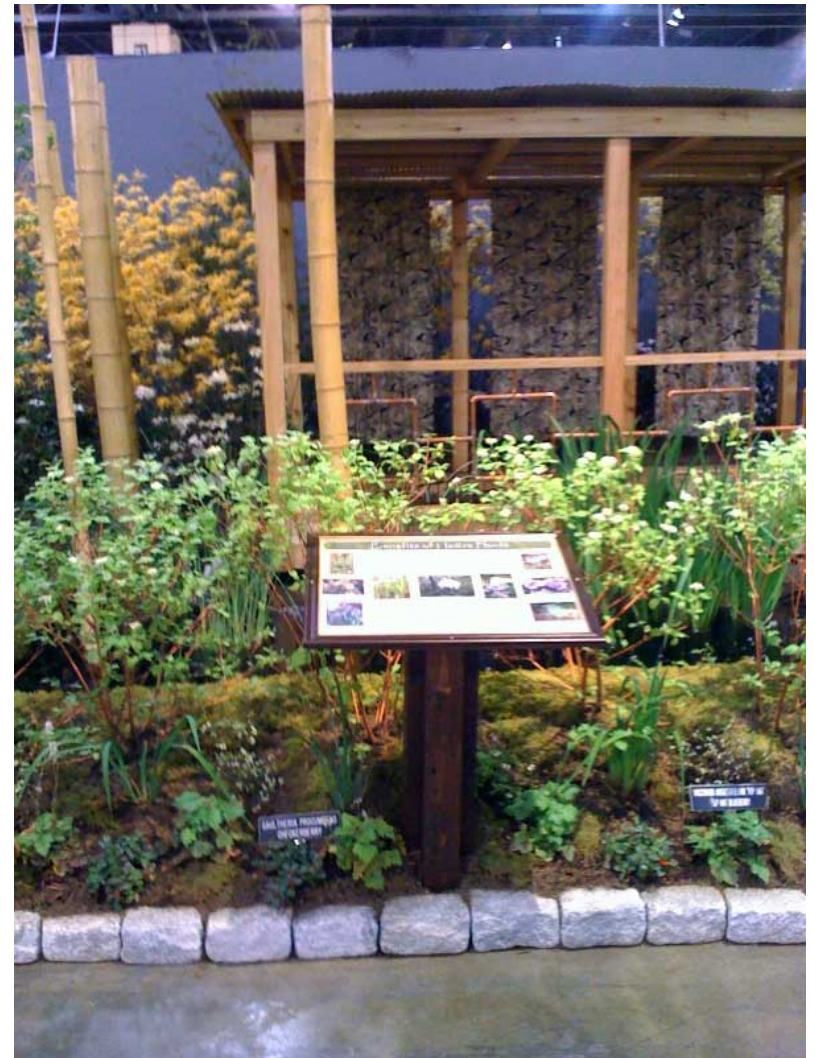

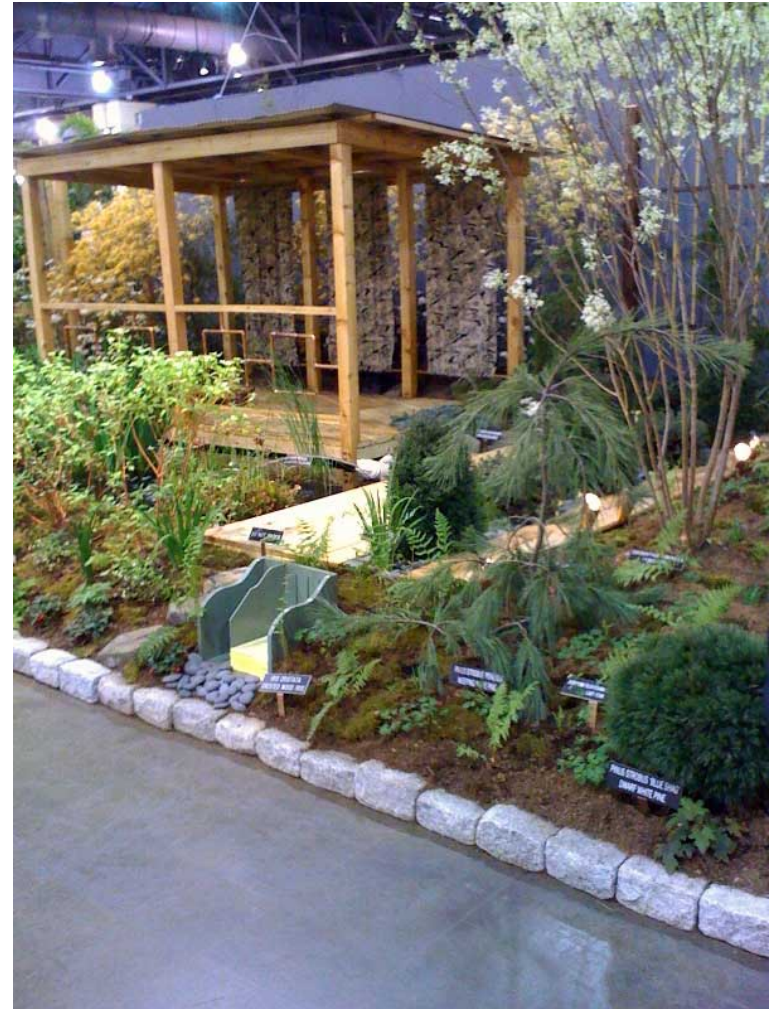
Our exhibit, “East Meets West,” from left to right.



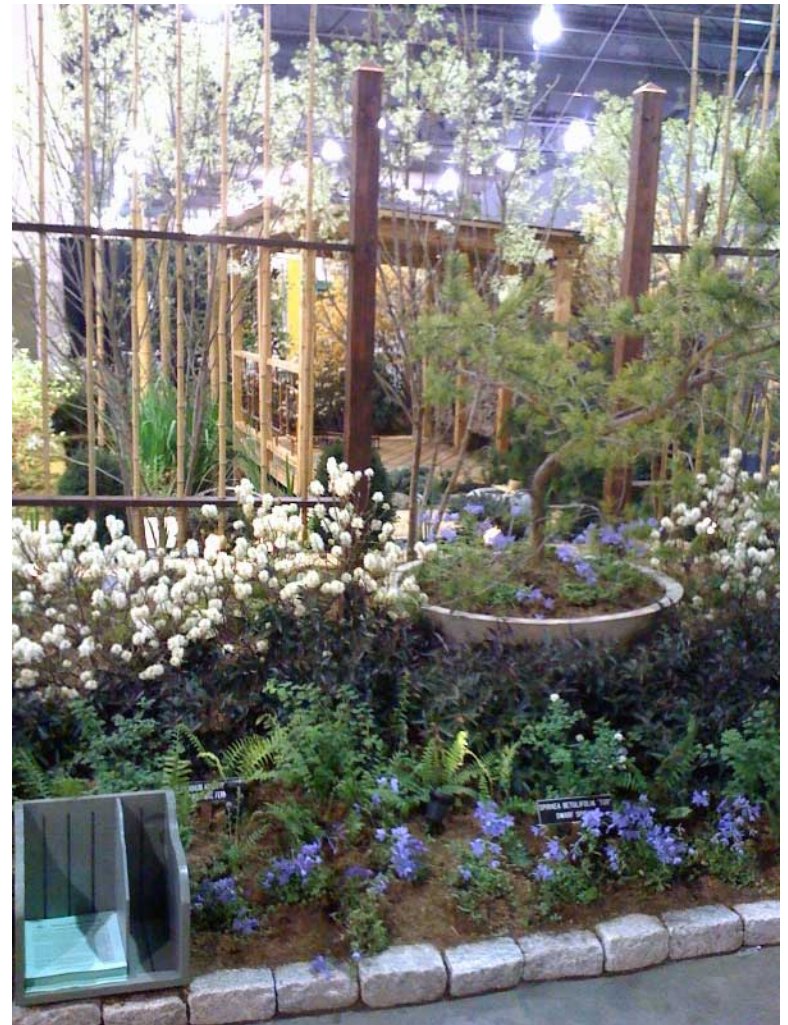
A Japanese style tea-house is set in a picturesque North American native garden.
