



## **TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO BROWNFIELD (TAB) COMMUNITIES PROGRAM**

### **What is TAB?**

TAB is a technical assistance and training program, funded through a grant provided by the USEPA, which is intended to serve as an independent resource to communities and nonprofits attempting to cleanup and reclaim brownfields.

### **Who Provides TAB Services?**

The New Jersey Institute of Technology (NJIT), through a cooperative agreement grant, maintains a multi-disciplinary team consisting of personnel with academic research, government, industry and consulting experience available to assist communities with their brownfield projects.

### **Who Can Receive TAB Assistance?**

Services are **FREE** to EPA Brownfield grantees in EPA Regions 1, 2 & 3 and those seeking to obtain EPA brownfield grants in Regions 1, 2 or 3.

### **What Services Can TAB Provide?**

NJIT provides a wide range of assistance in areas such as grant application preparation, site characterization, clean up technologies, sustainable development, government regulation, and community outreach. Assistance is provided through workshops, an NJIT TAB website (*coming soon*), direct technical mentoring and broad information sharing.
