



## U.S. EPA ANNOUNCES AN EXTENSION TO THE PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR THE HAVERTOWN PCP SUPERFUND SITE

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has extended the Public Comment Period for the Proposed Plan for the Havertown PCP Superfund Site located in Havertown Township, Delaware County, Pennsylvania. EPA published its recommendations for Operable Unit 3 (OU3) in a document called a Proposed Remedial Action Plan (Proposed Plan). EPA encourages the public to submit comments on the Proposed Plan.

OU3 has been divided into two separate units, OU3A and OU3B. OU3A addresses cleaning up the deep groundwater in the source area. OU3B addresses the contaminated soil and groundwater in the Recreational and Open Space area, located behind Rittenhouse Circle and adjacent to Washington Avenue.
