



U.S. EPA PROPOSES CLEANUP REMEDY FOR THE HAVERTOWN PCP SUPERFUND SITE

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has developed a Proposed Remedial Action Plan (PRAP) for the third and final Operable Unit (OU) for the Havertown PCP Superfund Site, located in Havertown Township, Delaware County, Pennsylvania. OU3 has been divided into two separate units, OU3A and OU3B. OU3A addresses cleaning up the deep groundwater in the source area and OU3B addresses the contaminated soil and groundwater in the Recreational and Open Space area, located behind Rittenhouse Circle and adjacent to Washington Avenue.

EPA will hold a public meeting to discuss the Proposed Plan for OU3. The public may submit comments on the PRAP during the 30-day public comment period.
