



Workshop: Treatment of Munitions and Explosives

The workshop is an opportunity for interested individuals to learn more about the cleanup process on Vieques Island. There will be presentations on what qualifies as unexploded ordnance, specific concerns about removing ordnance, and what is being done to protect residents as the work is proceeding. There will also be a question and answer period following the presentations.

EPA and EQB are inviting members of the public to participate in this workshop. This is an excellent opportunity for residents and interested individuals to learn more about the environmental cleanup on Vieques and the work currently under way.
