The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the above-referenced document pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) regulations (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508), and Section 309 of the Clean Air Act.

Based on our review, we have rated the SDEIS as Lack of Objections (LO) (see enclosed “Summary of Rating Definitions”). EPA supports the proposed action that will benefit various environmental resources. These include benefits to water quality from proposed new and modified prohibitions on discharges in the sanctuaries, including those from cruise ships, as well as several other actions beneficial to water quality. We commend the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) for this project, which will protect California’s rich offshore marine ecosystems.
