Over the past several months the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has been conducting a comprehensive evaluation of the Smithtown site called the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS). The purpose of this RI/FS is to gather information about the geological make up of the area and determine the direction in which the groundwater and contamination is moving.
