- Earn two different certifications

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be 18 years or older
- Be eligible for employment in the U.S.
- Have a high school diploma or GED
- Willing to participate in a two-week unpaid training program 8-9 hrs/day
- Have a valid driver's license
- Physically able to lift 50 pounds unassisted
- Be willing to work outdoors in all weather conditions
- Pass drug and background checks
