SUBJECT: Definition of Service Connection

An industrial production facility (located on a single site comprised of a contiguous tract of land) consists of six separate buildings all serviced by the same drinking water source -- a private on-site well. Does this non-community water system consist of six service connections or one service connection?

Response:

Each building serviced by the same non-community water system is considered to be a service connection of that system. Therefore, the above situation consists of six service connections.
