### Pacific Southwest Region

#### USDA Forest Service

- 18 National Forests in California
- •Over 20 million acres of public lands
- State and Private Forestry in Hawaii and the Affiliated Pacific Islands
- 10-year average:
  - **1**,339 fires
  - 320,673 acres burned

### 2017 Fire Season in California

- >9,000 fires including 1,526 on National Forests lands
- >1.5 million acres burned, including 644,640 on National Forest lands
- 11,953 structures damaged or destroyed
- 46 civilian fatalities
- Post-fire impacts



#### National Statistics (NIFC)

- 10,026,086 acres burned on federal, state, private land nationwide
- Includes 2.8 million acres of National Forest System lands burned
- 12,306 structures burned
- \$2.9 billion spent on wildfire suppression by U.S. Forest Service and U.S. Department of the Interior



# Precursors

- 6+ years of drought in California = 127 million dead trees
- Historic snowpack and rainfall = Increased grasses, underbrush and "ladder fuels"
- Increased fire activity at mid and lower elevations across the state
- **39** million people in California

# Support to North Bay Fires




## Santa Ana Wildfire Threat Index

- Reached "Purple" (Extreme) level for the first time (3<sup>rd</sup> year of use)
- Available for mobile devices also
- Increasing use by media and public especially in December


