According to the U.S. Bureau of the Census in 2003 about 18% of the population spoke a language other than English at home—of those, 61% spoke Spanish.

Did You Know...

Second generation Hispanics still speak and read in Spanish at home although they are fluent in English.

Did You Know...

Did You Know...

According to the 2000 census, Hispanics represent 14% of the total population in the United States—about 36 million. According to U.S. Census Bureau estimates, as of July 1, 2004, the Hispanic population has increased to approximately 41.3 million.
