Example Notification of Exemption

Paint Stripping and Miscellaneous Surface Coating Operations

Area Source Rule
40 CFR Part 63 Subpart HHHHHHH (§§63.11169–63.11180 and Table 1 to
Subpart HHHHHHH of 40 CFR Part 63)

An exemption from the requirements of Subpart HHHHHH is case/fact specific. This Example Notification of Exemption is completed to illustrate the type of information that you might submit to obtain an exemption through notification to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Administrator. You may use your own form as long as you include all the information required by the rule for a notification of exemption.

[Note that if you wish for a formal determination (confirmation of exemption), you may submit a petition as an alternative to the notification to the Administrator that you do not spray-apply any coatings that contain the target hazardous air pollutants (HAP). A separate example form is provided for the petition.]

In accordance with 40 CFR §63.11170(a)(2), an owner or operator of a motor vehicle or mobile equipment surface coating operation (including refinishing operations) may submit a notification to the Administrator that exempts the operation from the surface coating regulatory requirements of 40 CFR part 63, subpart HHHHHHH, if the owner or operator can demonstrate that the spray-applied coatings used by the facility do not contain target HAP. (Paint stripping requirements still apply.)

Note: In determining whether you spray-apply target HAP-containing coatings, do not include coatings applied using handheld aerosol cans, or hand-held devices (*e.g.*, spray guns) with a paint cup capacity of 3 fluid ounces or less. These are not considered spray-applied coatings under the rule. See "spray-applied coating operations" definition at 40 CFR §63.11180.

As defined in 40 CFR §63.11180, coatings are "target HAP containing coatings" if they contain compounds of chromium (Cr), lead (Pb), nickel (Ni), cadmium (Cd), or manganese (Mn) above a given concentration.

- Target HAP-containing coatings are defined to include coatings containing compounds of chromium, lead (Pb), nickel (Ni), or cadmium (Cd), if the metals are in amounts greater than or equal to 0.1% of the coating by mass.
- Target HAP-containing coatings also include coatings containing compounds of manganese (Mn), if the metal is in an amount greater than or equal to 1.0% of the coating by mass.
- Refer to the coating Safety Data Sheets (SDS) or obtain documentation from your supplier for each coating that you spray-apply without mixing. If you mix coatings prior to application, determine the target HAP concentration for each coating mixture that you spray-apply.

5. Where should I send this Notification of Exemption?

- a. Submit your notification of exemption to the EPA Administrator through the Compliance and Emissions Data Reporting Interface (CEDRI), which is located on EPA's Central Data Exchange (CDX): https://cdx.epa.gov. The CDX Web is the application used by EPA to manage the environmental data transmitted to EPA in order to meet EPA's electronic reporting requirements.
- b. If the State has been delegated the authority for this regulation under section 112(I) of the Clean Air Act, submit the notification to the appropriate State agency. For more information on state requirements, you can contact your Regional EPA air toxics office. Who may be subject to the rule and may need to use this form?

Spray painting of motor vehicles or mobile equipment is subject to 40 CFR part 63, subpart HHHHHH, unless exempted (see 40 CFR §63.11180 for definitions). The following will generally be subject to the rule:

- · Businesses at a fixed location
- Mobile operations that spray paint at various customer locations using their own equipment
- Individuals that coat more than 2 motor vehicles or pieces of mobile equipment per year without compensation, or any number for compensation

Who may submit a notification of exemption?

If you as the owner or operator of a facility are subject to the rule and do not spray-paint with any target HAP-containing coatings, then you may submit a notification of exemption from the spray-painting requirements of the rule. The example notification form references facilities, but any of the above may submit a notification of exemption provided that they are eligible.

If you are subject to the rule and do not obtain exemption (whether through petition or notification), then you are required to satisfy the rule requirements.

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An exemption from the requirements of Subpart HHHHHH is case/fact specific.
