SUMMARY: The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency [EPA] is issuing five-year Acid Rain permits, according to the Acid Rain Program regulations [40 CFR part 72], to the following 10 utility plants: Crist in Florida; Bailly, Clifty Creek, F B Culley, Frank E Ratts, Michigan City, and Warrick in Indiana; Jack Watson in Mississippi; and Kyger Creek and Walter C Beckjord in Ohio.
