The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) final rule for oil and natural gas operations, supports and encourages innovation in methane detection technology. This webinar will focus on the pathway in the final rule for the use of advanced methane detection technologies – such as satellite monitoring, aerial surveys and continuous monitors -- to find leaks and super emitter events.

During the webinar, EPA will give an overview of the advanced methane detection technology program, including details on what needs to be submitted in an alternative test method request, the process for submitting applications, and EPA's review process.
