ORDER


Upon consideration of the Joint Unopposed Motion to Terminate Consent Decree filed by Defendants Motiva Enterprises LLC, Equilon Enterprises LLC, and Deer Park Refining Limited Partnership (“the Shell Defendants”); Plaintiff the United States of America; and Plaintiff-Interveners the State of Louisiana, and the Northwest Clean Air Agency (fka Northwest Air Pollution Authority) of the State of Washington (collectively, “the Movants”), and the Memorandum of Law and other papers filed in support thereof, and the Court finding that it is in the public interest to terminate the Heaters and Boilers Consent Decree entered in this case on August 20, 2001 (Doc. No. 23); it is hereby

ORDERED that the Joint Motion to Terminate Consent Decree is GRANTED; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Heaters and Boilers Consent Decree is hereby terminated with respect to the Shell Defendants, specifically as to the following refineries, now or formerly owned and/or operated by the Shell Defendants:

- Convent, Louisiana (Motiva)
- Delaware City, Delaware (formerly Motiva)
- Norco, Louisiana (Motiva)
- Port Arthur, Texas (Motiva)
- Bakersfield, California (formerly Equilon)
- Los Angeles, California (formerly Equilon)
- Martinez, California (Equilon)
- Puget Sound, Washington (Equilon)
- Deer Park, Texas (owned by Deer Park Refining Limited Partnership and operated by Shell Oil Company)
