Subject Government Facility UST Compliance Report

Mr. Johnson;

After the USTCA 2005 bill was released, Indiana took a proactive approach in meeting the Government Facility UST Compliance initiative that was due on August 8, 2007. Indiana identified all local, state and federal UST facilities that remained to be inspected. These facilities were inspected over the last 20 months and those few that were not in compliance were brought into compliance. It is Indiana's position that we bring non-compliant facilities into compliance as rapidly as possible. We had no problems with government facilities. All government facilities are in compliance with Indiana's Rule 329 IAC 9.
