
We are in receipt of your renewal application dated May 12, 2008, supporting documentation dated May 14, 2010, and updated renewal application dated February 14, 2014. Additional application information we requested and received in our office on November 3, 2008 through September 2, 2015, provided clarification for statements contained in the renewal application.

In accordance with Title V of the Clean Air Act and 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 71, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has determined that cause exists for a renewal of the subject permit. Requirements found in 40 CFR 71.11 state that notice shall be provided on the preparation of a draft permit. The EPA will publish a public notice of the permitting action in a local newspaper of general circulation and allow for a 30-day public comment period. We will notify you of the date of public notice for submission of comments and the opportunity to request a public hearing.

Enclosed is a copy of the statement of basis, public notice, and draft permit for your review. Copies of these documents may also be obtained at the EPA Region 6 Web Site: <http://yosemite.epa.gov/r6/Apermit.nsf/Part71>. The draft permit and the statement of basis will also be available at the Jicarilla Apache Library in Dulce, New Mexico. The EPA will consider and answer all comments in making its final decision on the draft permit and keep a record of the persons commenting and the issues raised during the public participation process.
