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**GENERAL INFORMATION**

The eligible Island\* of **[Island Name]** submits this application for Fiscal Year (FY) 2012 *Notice of Intent to Continue* that is due on or before **Tuesday, May 1, 2012, at 11:59 p.m.** Pacific Standard Time to ***cleandiesel@epa.gov***. This notice identifies plans for submitting an application to amend the current DERA State Program award and receive FY 2012 Funding for the State Clean Diesel Grant Program. Allowable activities are described in the Diesel Emissions Reduction Act of 2010, 42 USC 16131 *et seq.* All projects must reduce diesel emissions. Islands must select State Clean Diesel Program projects in accordance to the same statutory priorities as the national competitive program.

\*"Islands" include the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Guam, American Samoa, and the United States Virgin Islands.

## FUNDING ALLOCATION

The Island of [Island Name] understands that State Program funds for FY 2012 will be allocated based on the formula outlined at 42 USC 16133(c). Specifically, if all 51 States\*\* and all eligible Islands participate in the State Program, each Island will each receive a base allocation of 0.472% of 2/3 of FY 2012 funds appropriated to the DERA State Program.

The eligible Island awards may be higher or lower depending on the number of States and Islands participating (notification of the final amount is expected to occur by Monday, May 7, 2012). If the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico elects to match the entire base EPA State Clean Diesel Program, funds will be awarded an additional amount of approximately \$56,000. If Guam, the United States Virgin Islands, American Samoa, and/or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands choose to match the entire base EPA State Clean Diesel Program funds, they will be awarded an additional amount of approximately \$14,000. If fewer than the 51 States and all the eligible Islands participate in the State Program, then each participating State and Island will receive more than the estimated funding amounts described above as dictated by the formula detailed at 42 U.S.C. 16133(c)(2)(B). Please note that, in such a circumstance, an increased match amount will be required to receive the bonus funds.

Note: The source of match provided by the Island will need to be approved by EPA.

## APPLICATION AND WORKPLAN

The Island of [Island Name] understands that an approvable one-year work plan amendment that details FY 2012 funded eligible projects, an updated budget, and any other required forms must be submitted to the EPA Regional Office on or before **Friday, June 1, 2012, at 11:59 p.m. Pacific Standard Time**.
