RE: Long-Term Stewardship (LTS) Site Inspection of SABIC Innovative Plastics Facility

WVDEP conducted a Long-Term Stewardship (LTS) site visit at the SABIC Innovative Plastics Facility on Tuesday, September 30, 2014. This WVDEP Project Manager met with John Garner, Site EHS&S Manager for SABIC Innovative Plastics.

Elements of the final remedy that needed to be confirmed during the site visit included the continued operation, maintenance and inspection activities at Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 14 Former Landfill A; SWMU 17 Former Landfill D; SWMU 39 Environmental Building Operations Wash Rack; and, Area Of Concern (AOC) H Diesel Fuel Tank Area.

A visual inspection of SWMUs 14 and 17 found that the covers of both landfills have been properly maintained and no erosional features were observed. Additionally, the slope stability is checked on a quarterly basis; inspection forms for Q4 2013 to Q3 2014 were provided by the Facility.

A visual inspection of the wash rack in SWMU 39 was conducted and no deficiencies were identified. Additionally, the environmental operations building wash rack is inspected on a quarterly basis; inspection forms for Q4 2013 to Q3 2014 were provided by the Facility.

A visual inspection of the secondary containment pad and sump associated with AOC H and no staining or odors were observed. Additionally, the containment pad and sump associated with AOC H is inspected on a quarterly basis; inspection forms for Q4 2013 to Q3 2014 were provided by the Facility.

The Facility is surrounded by a guarded security fence that appeared to be in good condition and the only access onto the Facility is through the locked gates.
