Dear Mr. Brooks:

In a letter dated January 25, 2011, the state of Iowa submitted designation recommendations for the revised 2010 primary National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) for nitrogen dioxide (NO₂). This letter is being submitted to provide clarification concerning the size of the designated area as recommended by the State of Iowa in that letter. The state of Iowa also recognizes EPA's intent, as provided in a June 28, 2011 letter, to initially designate all areas in Iowa as "unclassifiable/attainment."

To ensure that the size of the designated area is consistent with the State of Iowa's objectives for meeting air quality prevention of significant deterioration and economic growth goals, it is recommended that each of the 99 counties in Iowa be designated individually as "unclassifiable/attainment" until the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) redesignates areas, as appropriate after sufficient air quality data from the new monitoring network are available.
