The **San Juanico Disaster** was an industrial =isaster caused by a massive series of explosions at a liquid =etroleum gas (LPG) tank farm in San Juanico, Mexico (outside of Mexico City, Mexico) on November 19, 1984. The explosions consumed 11,000 cu. meters of gas, representing one third of Mexico City's entire liquid petroleum gas =upply. The explosions destroyed the facility and devastated the local town of San =uan Ixhuatepec, with 500–600 people killed, and 5000–7000 =thers suffering severe burns.<sup>[1]</sup> The San Juanico Disaster was one of the deadliest industrial disasters in world history.
