## Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, nearly one million septic systems treat wastewater from homes and businesses, serving more than a third of Washington State's population; and

**WHEREAS**, Washington's on-site wastewater professionals use their expertise in the design, installation, maintenance, and regulation of septic systems in our state; and

**WHEREAS**, citizens and the environment of the state of Washington benefit from properly-designed, installed, operated, and maintained septic systems; and

**WHEREAS**, proper septic system use and routine care are vital to protecting public health; preserving our highly valued groundwater, lakes, streams, and Puget Sound; and avoiding costly repairs that can result from neglect; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Environmental Protection Agency's SepticSmart program, used by Washington State health agencies, educates homeowners about the need for proper septic system use and routine maintenance and encourages them to do so;

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Jay Inslee, Governor of the state of Washington, do hereby proclaim the week of September 19-23, 2016, as

in the state of Washington, and encourage all people in our state to join me in this special observance.
