Chapter 06 General Emission Standards, Prohibitions, and Restrictions

.04 Carbon Monoxide in Areas III and IV.

- A. Applicability and Exceptions.
 - (1) This regulation is applicable only in Areas III and IV.
- (2) This regulation applies to any person who owns or operates any installation that discharges carbon monoxide gas at a rate exceeding 500 pounds (227 kilograms) per day and at a concentration exceeding 12 percent by volume.
 - (3) This regulation does not apply to any person who owns or operates:
- (a) Coking process equipment used directly in the manufacture of metallurgical coke by the pyrolysis of coal in the absence of air;
 - (b) Process equipment subject to COMAR 26.11.11.04B; or
 - (c) Installations subject to COMAR 26.11.10.06.
- (4) A person is exempt from the requirements of this regulation if he demonstrates to the satisfaction of the Department that the:
- (a) Gas mixture containing the carbon monoxide will not support combustion due to the presence of noncombustible gases; and
- (b) Carbon monoxide emissions will not cause or contribute to a violation of the National Ambient Air Quality Standard or Prevention of Significant Deterioration requirement for carbon monoxide.

B. General Requirements.

- (1) A person may not cause or permit the discharge of carbon monoxide gas into the atmosphere from any installation unless it is burned in a direct flame afterburner with excess oxygen for at least 0.3 seconds at a temperature of at least 1,300 deg F.
- (2) The direct flame afterburner shall be equipped with a properly functioning recording pyrometer located and positioned in the work area so that it is readily visible to the operator of the installation.
