Chapter 123 -- Standards for Contaminants

SULFUR COMPOUND EMISSIONS

§123.24. Primary zinc smelters.

- (a) No person shall cause, suffer or permit the emission into the outdoor atmosphere of sulfur oxides from any zinc roasting operation in such a manner that the concentration of sulfur oxides, expressed as SO₂, in the effluent gas exceeds 500 parts per million by volume, dry basis, calculated as a 2-hour moving average.
- (b) No person may permit the emission into the outdoor atmosphere of sulfur oxides from any zinc sintering operation at any time in excess of the rate calculated by the following formula:

Y = 0.054X

where:

X = Calcine feed rate to the sinter plant (lbs/hr); and

Y = Allowable sulfur oxide emissions (lbs/hr).
