

**Final title V Operating Permit for Williams Four Corners LLC – Los Mestenos Compressor Station, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Permit Number R6FOP-NM-04-R2**

EPA is issuing the final title V Operating Permit Number R6FOP-NM-04-R2, as proposed, for the Williams Four Corners (WFC) LLC – Los Mestenos Compressor Station. The EPA prepared a draft permit and held a public comment period from June 9<sup>th</sup> through July 10<sup>th</sup> 2017. EPA also offered the public an opportunity to request a public hearing. No public comments or requests for public hearing were received during the comment period.

This compressor station operates under an existing Part 71 permit that has to be renewed every five years pursuant to the CAA. The location of the Los Mestenos Compressor Station is 15 miles northwest of Gavilan, New Mexico. At the Los Mestenos Compressor Station facility, natural gas is compressed using one natural gas-fired turbine and one reciprocating compressor engine with emission controls and associated equipment. The facility compresses and dehydrates natural gas prior to entering the natural gas pipeline. This compressor station is located on Jicarilla Apache tribal land in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. There are no new construction activities associated with the renewal of this final title V operating permit. This title V permit is effective immediately upon issuance on August 08, 2017.
