



Purpose:

The EPA is holding today's public hearing to receive comments on the EPA's proposed Clean Air Act Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) permit to be issued to Palmdale Energy, LLC for the Palmdale Energy Project (Project). The Project:

- Is a natural gas-fired power plant that would generate up to 645 megawatts of electricity
- Would be located on 50 acres near U.S. Air Force Plant 42
- Is designed to provide fast response to changes in electricity demand, resulting primarily from changes to the availability of energy from renewable energy sources

Comments:

Today, we are seeking your comments on our proposed permit and the Project, including such matters as:

- 1. The best available control technology (BACT) determination for emissions of NOx, CO, PM, PM₁₀, PM_{2.5} and greenhouse gas;
- 2. The effects, if any, on Class I areas; and
- 3. The effect of the proposed modification, if any, on ambient air quality.
