In your letter of January 19, 1983 you suggested that the State of Michigan may wish to request an automatic delegation of the New Source performance Standards (NSPS) and the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAPS). We agree an automatic delegation process would be a more efficient way of handling the state implementation of new categories of NSPS and NESHAPS, should they be promulgated by U.S. EPA.

Therefore, we request the following:

- I. The authority to implement and enforce any new or amended NSPS categories and NESHAPS which have been promulgated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency since the last delegation of these programs, January 4, 1982.
- 2. The automatic delegation of any future new NSPS and NESHAPS categories or any new revisions to existing categories. However, due to unforeseen constraints such as budget reductions, etc., the State of Michigan reserves the right to refuse to accept delegation of any new NSPS or NESHAPS categories upon notification to EPA.

This delegation request is based on the regulation and enforcement procedures as specified in our January 4, 1982 request. Since that time no significant regulation or policy changes have been made by this agency.
