

What's New in this version?

Version 2.0.17 of the Air Tool contains updates and revisions to the prior version, 2.0.16. These updates have been implemented to enhance the usefulness, clarity and accuracy of the Tool, and are summarized below:

- The Contacts Section has been updated to clarify the relationship between Sustainability Contacts and other contacts.
- Air carriers now have their maximum average payload set to 58 tons, corresponding to the
 maximum payload capacity for the largest aircraft make/model specified by SmartWay partners.
 Payloads above this amount will trigger a "red" out of range error that must be explained by the
 partner in order to proceed. Payloads between 29 and 58 tons will receive a "yellow" warning
 which may be explained if the partner so chooses.
- The "Feedback" section of the tool has been updated making it easier to follow and complete.
