In accordance with the Clean Air Act (CAA), as amended (42 U.S.C. 7401 et seq.), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed your application for a Synthetic Minor New Source Review (MNSR) Permit for the Lindrith Compressor Station. The EPA proposed both a draft permit for public comment and a notice of opportunity for a public hearing regarding the above application on January 24, 2018.

During the public comment period there were no public comments received from the general public, but in the final permit we have addressed your request to correct the typographical errors for the Serial Numbers in the equipment list for the engines A-01 - A-03 and EMERGEN.
