
This is to notify you that your request, dated July 27, 2017, for the rescission of the PSD permit (PSD-NM-1644-M1) for the Lindrith Compressor Station has been approved. The EPA will issue a synthetic minor NSR permit to replace your PSD permit. In conjunction with the permitting decision and the EPA's review of the information on the operation of the Lindrith Compressor Station and your associated permits, we believe your request meets the PSD permit rescission requirements of 40 CFR § 52.21(w)(2)-(3). Therefore, we will rescind your PSD permit and publish a public notice announcing our decision. As noted in the enclosed EPA guidance, please be aware that this rescission approval does not offer relief from other statutory or regulatory provisions that may apply to the Lindrith Compressor Station.

The public notice for the EPA's approval of your rescission request will be published on March 7, 2018. A copy of the public notice and basis of decision are enclosed for your information. The public notice will be electronically public noticed on the EPA website at: www.epa.gov/publicnotices.

The agency action on the rescission allows the public to request a review of the agency's action by the EPA's Environmental Appeals Board and also may be subject to judicial review under Section 307(b)(1) of the Clean Air Act, in the United States Court of Appeals.
