The United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 9 (EPA) has conducted an initial review of your Request for Coverage under the *General Air Quality Permit for New or Modified Minor Source Stone Quarrying, Crushing, and Screening Facilities in Indian Country*. Oscar Renda Contracting, Inc. (ORCI) proposes to construct and operate a portable aggregate crushing/screening operation in McKinley and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, within the Navajo Nation tribal land.

ORCI's Request for Coverage application was submitted pursuant to the Tribal New Source Review regulations at 40 CFR 49.156. The EPA received your request on February 21, 2018. As part of the 45-day completeness review outlined in 40 CFR 49.156(e)(4), EPA has 30 days to review your Request for Coverage for completeness and request additional information in writing. We have determined that your application is complete and contains all the information necessary to complete our review. Note that as the EPA continues review of your application we may identify further information that will be essential to enable the EPA to continue processing your application to make a decision to approve your request for coverage.
