GUIDELINES

The following guidelines are hereby adopted and promulgated pursuant to Article IV, Section I.

(1) No burning within the city limits of Norton Shores, Muskegon Heights, Roosevelt Park, City of Muskegon, the City of North Muskegon and the western section of Muskegon Township and the southern portion of Laketon Township,

(2) There shall be no open burning after January 1, 1974 within the cities of Whitehall, and Montague and the villages of Fruitport, Ravenna, Casnovia and Lakewood Club.

(3) No burning within 300 feet of another occupied dwelling.

(4) No burning in any subdivision that contains 20 or more residences.

(5) Open burning, by permit only, in rural areas that are qualified by not being included in the above restricted areas. These permits will be issued by the local fire department.
