I understand that I may contact LRI (and vice versa) at the start of the 60 day period to discuss periods that may be unavailable for sampling due to routine maintenance or following the off-site shipment of the facilities scrap metal inventory. I will call EPA if these periods significantly reduce the available days for sampling. (Note: LRI may contact me if unforeseen events occur during the 60-day period that might prevent my sampling.)
