- Note that the September 1, 1988 <u>Federal Register</u> (Revision Checklist 113) incorrectly labels this paragraph "264.141" rather than "265.141."
- 2 The text of 265.142(a)(1) was originally included in 265.142(a).
- 3 Note that there is an error in the September 16, 1992 <u>Federal Register</u> (Revision Checklist 113). In the preamble text at the bottom of the second column at 57 <u>FR</u> 42834, "265.143(e)(11)" should be "265.143(e)(10)".
- Note that an error which appears in the July 1, 1989, 1990 and 1991 CFRs was only partially corrected in the July 1, 1992 CFR. The July 1, 1989, 1990 and 1991 CFRs incorrectly omit 265.147(a)(1)(i) & (ii) and 265.147(b)(1)(i) & (ii). The September 23, 1991 correction to the CFR published in the Federal Register (56 FR 47912) reinstated 265.147(a)(1)(i) & (ii) but erroneously did not reinstate 265.147(b)(1)(i) & (ii). Thus, the CFR had omitted 265.147(b)(1)(i) & (ii) beginning with the July 1, 1992 edition until the Revision Checklist 214 final rule (71 FR 40254; July 14, 2006) reinstated the provisions.
- 5 Note that the changes addressed by the September 1, 1988 (53 <u>FR</u> 33938) final rule at 265.147(a)(2) are optional, whereas the July 1, 1991 (56 <u>FR</u> 30200) changes are required.
- The September 1, 1988 rule (Revision Checklist 113) added 265.147(a)(7) and (b)(7) to the code, and the September 16, 1992 rule (Revision Checklist 113) revised them (including adding 265.147(a)(7)(iii) and (b)(7)(iii)). Note that the preamble of the September 1, 1988 Federal Register incorrectly characterized these paragraphs as less stringent. The September 16, 1992 Federal Register clarified this issue by stating that, in fact, these paragraphs are more stringent because they address an additional reporting requirement. The amendment made by the September 16, 1992 rule made these requirements less stringent than those introduced by the September 1, 1988 rule. Thus, those States that adopted the more stringent September 1, 1988 provisions are not required to adopt the amendments made by the September 16, 1992 rule, although EPA urges them to do so. States that did not adopt the September 1, 1988 requirements at 265.147(a)(7) and (b)(7) should not do so but should adopt the clarified, less stringent version promulgated by the September 16, 1992 rule.
- 7 The September 1, 1988 (53 <u>FR</u> 33938) erroneously indicates that 265.147(b)(5) is a new paragraph to be added. In fact, this final rule replaced the old 265.147(b)(5), introduced as part of the base program, with a new paragraph (b)(5).
- 8 Revision Checklist 113 (53 <u>FR</u> 33938; September 1, 1988) changed the heading for this paragraph by removing "corporate" before "guarantee."
- 9 Citations within the double lines are optional, but if a State chooses to modify its program to adopt requirements equivalent to these provisions, it must adopt such requirements as a unit rather than by individual provision. In other words, all or none of these provisions must be included in a State's code. Subsequent changes to these provisions may or may not be optional for States that have adopted the original unit of provisions. An optional sign appears in front of the subsequent revision checklist number(s) if such subsequent changes are less stringent than or reduce the scope of the original requirements.
- 10 Note that only 265.147(g)(1)(ii) is removed and reserved; 265.147(g)(1)(i) remains as it was prior to the Page 29 of 30

Although not included in Checklist IV B, the text of the old 265.147(h) (now 265.147(k)) was included in the base program as 265.147(g). The paragraph was designated as 265.147(h) by Revision Checklist 27.
- 12 Note that there is a typographical error in the September 1, 1988 <u>Federal Register</u> (53 <u>FR</u> 33938, Revision Checklist 113): "264.151(1)" [number 1], should be "264.151(1) [letter "1"].
- 13 The final rule addressed by Revision Checklist 237 (81 FR 85732; November 28, 2016) also removed the comment following 265.174.
- 14 Revision Checklist 28 completely revised this base program (Checklist IV B) section, 265.190.
- 15 Revision Checklist 28 completely reorganized and revised the regulations pertaining to tank systems which originally appeared in Checklist IV B at 265.191 through 265.194 and 265.197.
- Revision Checklist 213 (71 FR 16862, April 4, 2002) removed the existing 265.193(a)(2) through (a)(4) and redesignated the existing (a)(5) as (a)(2) with revisions.
- 17 Revision Checklist 213 (71 FR 16862, April 4, 2002) removed subparagraphs 265.193(a)(1) through (5) and completely revised the remaining (a) paragraph. The rule also redesignated the existing (b) and (c) paragraphs as (f) and (g) and added the new 265.193(b) through e).
- 18 The Revision Checklist 237 final rule removed the Performance Track provision at 265.195(d).
